THE SYRACUSE STAMP CLUB ANNOUNCES:

SYRAPEX 2009, AN EXHIBITION AND BOURSE

PLACE: Holiday Inn at Carrier Circle, 6555 Old Collamer Road South, East Syracuse, New York 13057

TIME: Saturday November 7th 2009 from 10:00 A.M. – 5:30 P.M., and
Sunday November 8th 2009 from 10:00 A.M. – 4:30 P.M.

SYRAPEX 2009 will feature philatelic exhibits in open competition, along with a Bourse of 20 Dealers, a United States Postal Service Temporary Philatelic Station, and a youth area. Philatelic Material of the highest quality will be available.

SYRAPEX 2009 show theme is the “90th Anniversary of the Syracuse Stamp Club”. A special cacheted show cover will be available each day at the show. A different cancel will be used each day. Mail orders for the covers must include a #10 SASE and should be sent to the Syracuse Stamp Club, PO Box 593, East Syracuse, NY 13057. Covers are \$3.00 each. The awards banquet will be held Saturday, November 8th at 7:00 P.M. at the Holiday Inn at 6555 Old Collamer Road South, East Syracuse, New York 13057. EXHIBITION RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. The SYRAPEX 2009 Exhibition is a 16-page frame open competition for all philatelists, under the condition that all stamps and covers are bona fide property of the exhibitor. Junior exhibitors are welcome and will receive separate judging. The age limit for juniors is 16 years or under.
2. The signed application for entry must be received by the Exhibit Chairman, Michael Ammann, Syracuse Stamp Club, PO Box 593, East Syracuse, NY 13057-0593 by October 1st, 2009, to be listed in the official SYRAPEX 2009 Show Program. The Exhibit Chairman reserves the right to refuse entries arriving after this date. Each entry must be on a separate entry form.
3. The entry fee is \$5.00 per 16-page frame, \$2.00 for junior exhibitors. The entry fee must accompany the application form when submitted. The SYRAPEX 2009 Show Committee will provide all frames. The Committee also reserves the right to limit the number of submissions and or number of frames by any one entrant. All frames will be sold on a first come, first served basis.
4. The Exhibit Chairman must receive all exhibits by November 5th, 2009. Exhibits will be securely stored to insure their safety. The Show Committee will mount all exhibits. The Show Committee also reserves the right to refuse exhibits not received by November 5th, 2009. Refused exhibits will have their entry fee returned. The Show Committee will also be present during the dismounting and repackaging of all exhibit material at the close of the exhibition.
5. No exhibits may be removed from the Exhibit Hall prior to the closing of the show, Sunday, November 8th, 2009, at 4:30 P.M. All exhibitors or their agents must sign a release at the time of removal of their entry. Payment must be made in advance to Exhibit Chairman, Michael Ammann, for postage and insurance costs for the return of exhibits not picked up in person.

6. Well-known Central New York Philatelists will do judging. Exhibits will be unclassified and judged on individual merit. Exhibits will be judged against each other for the Best in Show Award and two runners up. Judges or members of their families may enter exhibits but on a non-competitive basis only.
 7. Due care and precautions will be taken to protect all exhibits from loss or damage. Security guards will be on duty each day of the exhibition. However, no responsibility or liability may be attached to the Syracuse Stamp Club, the SYRAPEX 2009 Show Committee, or the Holiday Inn, including their officers, members, or employees for any loss whatsoever. The signing of the Official Entry Form by the exhibitor shall indicate acceptance of these rules and regulations.
